PRACTICE SITE

Open a new NotePad (PC), TextEdit (MAC), or other text editor document and save it as ***poem.html*** in your week1 folder.

, <div> and <h1> tags, and the attributes and values discussed in the lab lesson during week 1, write the following as it appears in the layout below. Make sure you include the required coding for a basic web page.

A Really Bad Poem

 So I told myself, "harder, use all your might"
 Moments later came a brilliant flash of light

Make sure you have a double space between the title and the first stanza and between each stanza. Lines within the stanzas should display as singled spaced.

Be sure to check it in your browser before submitting it. Many times it is difficult to see small coding errors without checking your work in a browser. Remember, there are no small errors- it's either right or wrong when coding, and the smallest punctuation change will break the code.
