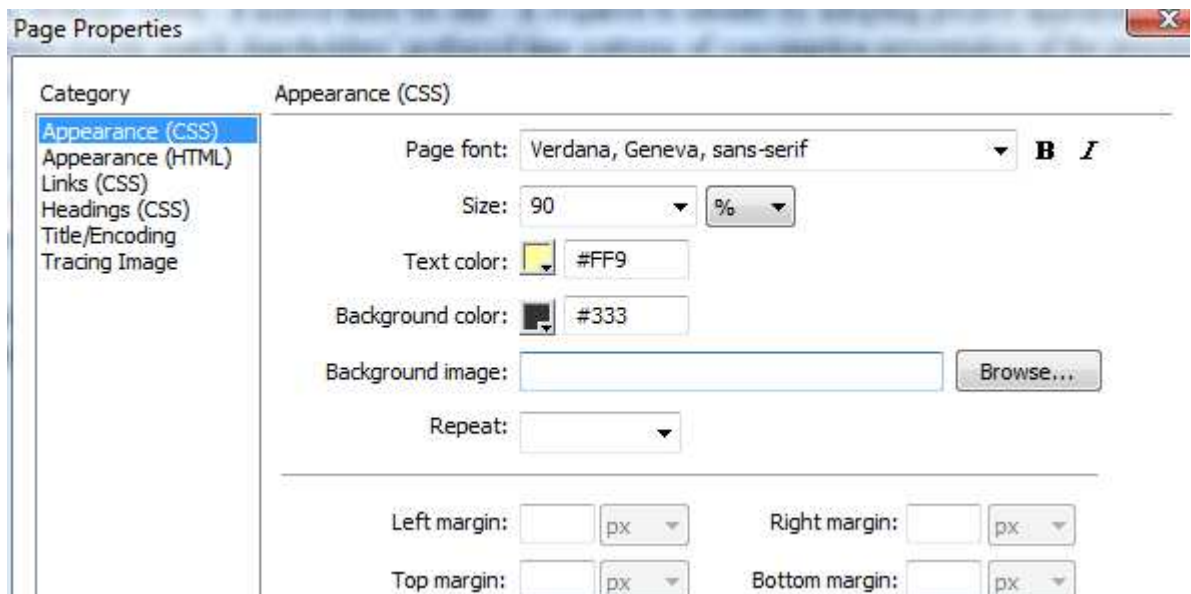
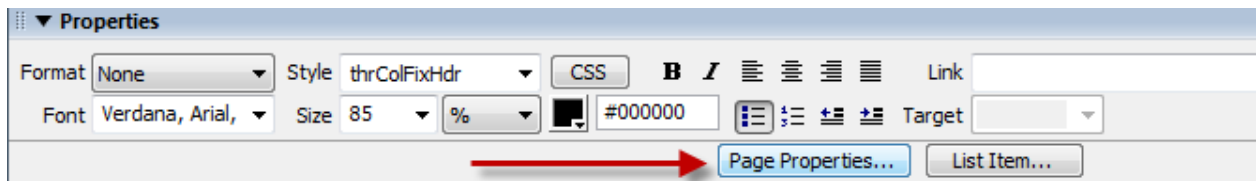
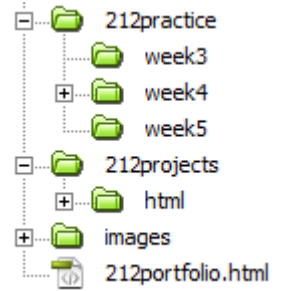
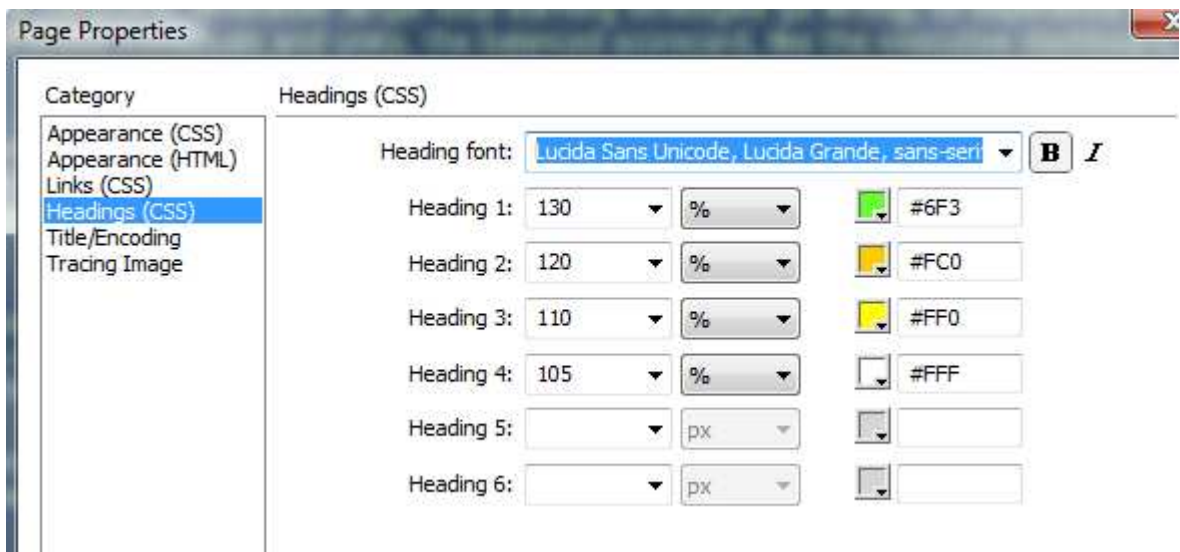
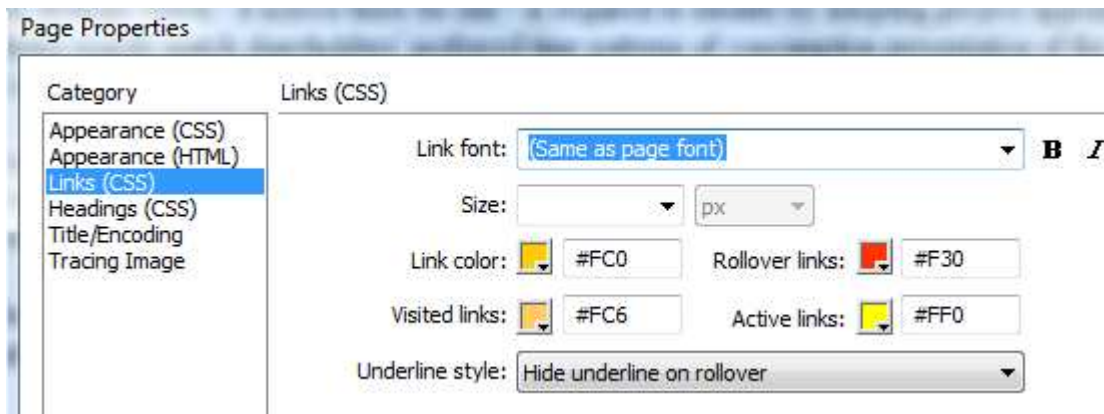


WEEK 5 WARM UP

1. Launch Dreamweaver.
2. If you are on campus, import your site definition. If you are at home, your site should already be defined – we did that in week 3.
3. Create a new folder named *week5* in your *212practice* folder. Create 4 new pages within the folder. (page1.html, page2.html, page3.html, page4.html)
4. Type some text on each page.
5. Use the format pull-down in the property inspector to create a heading 1 (h1 tag) and heading 2 (h2 tag) on each page. Leave other formatting alone (no fonts).
6. Insert an image on each page. Why are alt labels important?
7. Add links to page1.html, page2.html, page3.html, and page4.html on each page. You can create them on page1.html and then copy & paste to the other pages.
8. Use F12 to preview your work. (Opt F12 on Mac)
9. Upload your work and look at it on the server (<http://studentweb.gccd.net/user.name/212practice/week5>)
10. Open page1.html and use Page Properties button in Property Inspector to set font, background, heading, and link properties. Use the screen shots as a guide - choose your own colors.



Notice that you can tap the Apply button to see the changes.



11. When you finish, look at the code to see how Dreamweaver codes the changes within the style tag on the page. Save, preview, upload, and test. How do the links behave in the browser?
