

## CIS 213 Dreamweaver Review

For this review, you will create a small web site about design.

1. Create a local root folder - name it **213root**. This will be where you put all your web files for the semester.
2. Launch Dreamweaver and create a site definition for the class.  
host: cis9.cuyamaca.net  
user: first.last  
password: 6-digit birthday (e.g. 021985)
3. In Dreamweaver, create a new folder named *projects*. Within this folder, create a new page with a 2-column CSS layout with a header and footer. Use CSS to set fonts and a harmonious color scheme and move the CSS to an external style sheet. Set up the navigation as a library item. Add your name and revision date in the footer.
4. Duplicate the page. You want to end up with 5 pages.
5. Add content to each page. Each page should briefly explain a design or usability principle infrom CIS 212 or GD 217 (i.e. CARP, color design, information design, etc.). Use your OWN WORDS.
6. On each page, create links to each page in the sidebar column.
7. On each page, type a heading in the header div of the table. This should be formatted as a heading1.
8. Add a title to each page (this will show up in the title bar of the browser).
9. Insert an image into the main content column of each page. You may download images from the Web (right click the image to save the image into your local root folder). Use a different image for each page.
10. Add alt text for each image.
11. Each page should link to the external CSS. There should be ONE CSS file that all pages link to.
12. Upload your folder and test your work on the server.
